Every entry at a recognized show shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that the person making it, along with the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, rider, driver and the horse : (1) shall be subject to the constitution and rules of the association and the local rules of the show; (2) that every rider, horse and driver are eligible as entered; (3) Agree that the judges decision is final; (4) that the owner, rider/driver and any of their agents or representatives agree to hold the show, their officials, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show, whether or not such injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the show.

Under Maine law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.
